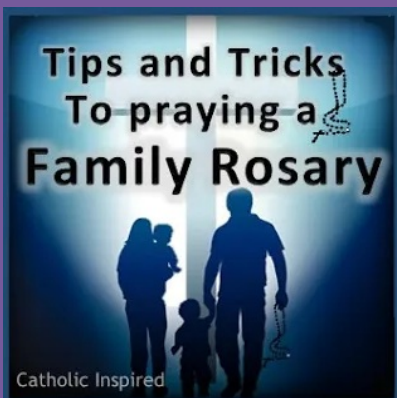
Quote:

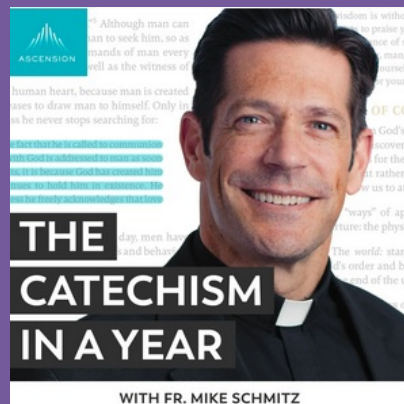
The Assignments:
