## Reflection:

We have evidence of God's love and care; unfortunately, like his disciples, we wonder if he cares enough. Why do we doubt his love or fail to trust that he cares for us? It is because sometimes he does not calm our storms or answer our prayers according to our plans. Most importantly, however, we often focus completely on our circumstances, failing to realize he is present with us. Our storms remind us to focus on him completely.

You know your Goliath. You recognize his walk, the thunder of his voice. He taunts you with bills you can't pay, people you can't please, habits you can't break, failures you can't forget, and a future you can't face. But just like David, you can face your giant, even if you aren't the strongest, the smartest, the best equipped, or the holiest. You could read his story and wonder what God saw in him. His life has little to offer the unstained, straight-A saint. He fell as often as he stood and stumbled as often as he conquered. But for those who know the sound of Goliath, David gives this reminder: Focus on giants -- you stumble; focus on God -- your giants tumble.
